I have Bunker 2 and I recently had a few entries that won't play back. Instead, I get the following message written in red: The problem arose when I opened files for this DVR event. Please note the error code: 05 I had a very similar problem a couple of years ago with my 722. But my bunker 2 was flawless up to this point. Has anyone seen this message? Does anyone know what that means? My current software is the S531, but I don't know how long I've had it. Means that the record doesn't work correctly, and now there's a way to see it. I can see it even in Bunker 3. Sometimes I get one entry with a 04 or 05 red alert and the record lasts less than a minute and then another one right over that record which works great for 59 minutes. As the timer did not fire right and had to restart. It's sporadic and comes and goes. I haven't seen that issue in quite some time, going quite often with my HWS and H3 early on. Hopper 3 has some downsides. 1) Its still in beta (virtually many bugs) 2) You can only watch one sling. 3) None of the entries is private. 4) Less space to record. 1) Its still in beta (virtually a lot of bugs) No offense, but it's a bit of a stretch to portray it to be that bad, IMO. With the exception of the OTA record, my H3 is as solid as any Hopper I've ever had. 3) None of the entries is private. This is one good point, though. I think the privacy and/or separation of records is probably the biggest thing the OP would like to consider. Do you mind if you, your wife, and your child's records all appear on one Hopper? If not, I'd say H3 and six Joeys would be the way to go. Of course, more tuners are available to handle the workload of seven viewing locations w/on potential recording and live TV conflicts.
